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About the College

Our Govt. College, Hodal, was earlier known as Brij Mandal College, which was started in 1968 by a management committee. The Brij Mandal College was taken over by the Govt. of Haryana in 1980 since then it is known as “Govt. College, Hodal”.

This college is situated in the Brij Area, which is 30 Km away from palwal district Headquarter and 60 Km from Mathura on Delhi to Agra National Highway. This College is situated in Hodal town, which is surrounded by greenery and has a pollution free atmosphere. This college is located in an urban area and is affiliated with M.D. University Rohtak since 1978. The College has shifted to new building in the year October 2020.

In new building we have ample infrastructure and facilities for the students who pursuing Higher Education. In terms of infrastructure, we have two Computer Labs with 50 computers and internet access as well as two Projectors. We have two Smart Class Rooms with modern technology, one English language lab, two fully equipped Geography labs.

On the ground floor of the new building we have admin block, library, gymnasium, auditorium and conference room connected with all the necessary facilities and internet connection. The campus is fully under the surveillance of CCTV Cameras.

For the students, we have separate water coolers, wash rooms, and Girls' common rooms at every floor of new college building which contains total 5 floors.

At present our college is providing Higher Education in Art, Commerce & Science (NM) faculties in Under Graduate & Post Graduate courses. In the present

session the total Number of students enrolled is 1195 out of which 804 are Girl students.

For the poor and socially and economically backward students, the college is providing various scholarship schemes like Consolidated Stipend Scheme for SC, NSP, PMSC scholarship out of grant received from Central and Haryana Government.

Inspite of above facilities the college is also running programme as NSS boys & Girls and NCC (Girls Unit).

Our college is a Government institute in which faculty is recruited by the Government. At present, we have 03 regular, 11 extension lecturers, 3 Computer faculty and 13 administrative staff.

The College has been assessed by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Banglore, India in 2016 and accredited by grade “B” as the college was running in the old building at that time.
